2. We often call our second set of teeth "adult teeth", but their official name is "permanent teeth". An adult with a full set of permanent teeth would have how many?

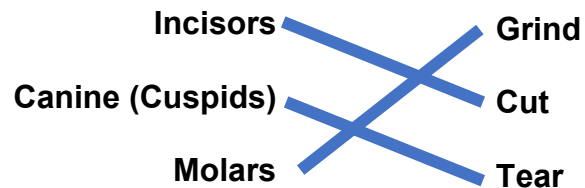
